7 An Act relating to counties and county officers;  
8 creating the Marvin Williams and Robbie Chase  
9 Whitebird County Sheriff Assistance Act; providing  
10 short title; authorizing certain nonprofit  
11 corporations to offer certain services under certain  
12 circumstances; providing for noncodification;  
13 providing for codification; and providing an  
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Marvin Williams  
19 and Robbie Chase Whitebird County Sheriff Assistance Act".

20 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 556 of Title 19, unless there is  
22 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 A corporation organized not-for-profit pursuant to the  
24 provisions of the Oklahoma General Corporation Act and that holds a  
valid exemption from federal income taxation issued pursuant to  
Section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code (26 U.S.C. Section

1 501(a)) and is listed as an exempt organization in Section 501(c) of  
2 the Internal Revenue Code (26 U.S.C. Section 501(c)) and is a  
3 statewide association of county sheriffs that represents the largest  
4 association of elected sheriffs of this state is hereby authorized  
5 to provide any available support services and/or assist in  
6 coordinating county law enforcement resources when any sheriff of  
7 this state requests such assistance.

8 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
